(T): Events followed by a (T) indicate events that have a hands-on component but will be conducted as **Test-Only** events at the 2021 National Tournament.

(V): Events followed by a (V) indicate events that have a hands-on component that will be conducted via a **Video** submission to the Event Supervisors for the 2021 National Tournament.

(L): Events followed by a (L) indicate events that have a hands-on component that will be conducted **Live** with Event Supervisors at the 2021 National Tournament. Teams will have the opportunity to self-schedule for these events prior to the National Tournament.
