BE SURE TO CHECK THE 2020 EVENT RULES for EVENT PARAMETERS and TOPICS FOR EACH COMPETITION LEVEL

EVENT FORMAT:

- Disease Detectives has a 3 part competition-with each part being about 1/3.
PART1 – BACKGROUND AND SURVEILLANCE
PART 2- OUTBREAK INVESTIGATION
PART 3-PATTERNS, CONTROL AND PREVENTION
- Format and material of the Division B and C event is similar except that the level of reasoning and math skills should be consistent with the grade level.
- Rules designate some topics for Division C only and/or National only
- Differences between the two levels should be reflected in both the type of questions asked and the scoring rubrics.
- **Be sure to check the event parameters in the rules for the resources allowed.**
- Format and material of the Division B and C event is similar except that the level of reasoning and math skills should be consistent with the grade level.
- Differences between the two levels should be reflected in both the type of questions asked and the scoring rubrics.
