#### **Team Instructions:**

1. The parent guide listed on the team confirmation form should CONTACT each member of his or her team to make arrangements for the evening of the event.

*Note: If you signed up to be a parent guide but were not chosen, it was due to an overage of volunteers in your age category. (New parent volunteers were given precedence over parents who have attended in past years.) If you would still like to be with your child's team, call the lead parent guide and let him/her know you'd like to come. Remember that we only assign one guide per team because of space restrictions -- we have about eight teams per session (30+ people), and that is all the small rooms can hold. We also discourage younger, non-school-age children from attending. Thank you!*

2. Decide on a TEAM NAME and TEAM COLOR. Have all team members wear the same color shirts, hats, whatever! Have fun with it. Each team member should also bring a PENCIL with eraser.

3. Please arrive at Edison by 6:45 p.m. with the parent guide and proceed DIRECTLY to your first event. See the attached map for room assignments (rooms are grouped together by grade level).

4. Register your TEAM NAME and TEAM COLOR with the Event Supervisor at your FIRST event.

5. Parent guides, please note that you are responsible for the conduct and whereabouts of the students on your team at all times that evening. Please wait at the school until all members of your team are picked up at the end of the night, or make arrangements to carpool.
