## Sample Crime Scene 1 Prank

The paper used to stop up the toilet had ink on it. You have a chromatogram of the ink. Immediately after the flood, the suspects were searched and their pens confiscated. You have examples of the chemicals found on the scene. 3 prints were lifted from the scene and you have examples of the suspects finger prints. In addition you have examples of hair and fiber found at the scene. You will need to identify the chemicals, the type of hair and fibers found at the scene and the types of fingerprints. You will also need to make a chromatogram of the suspects ink and decide on the basis of the evidence which of the suspects is the most likely perpetrator.
